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Course Description: Media Design provides students with experience in reporting, photography, image editing, layout design, page layout programs, writing, copy editing, and more. Students will compose, construct, and edit all elements of text layout, graphic art, and photography in a publication that exemplifies OCSI's tradition of excellence.

Class Text: Jostens Yearbook Avenue (Online program)

Course Objectives:

- Students will understand, practice and learn skills for applying ethical and legal considerations to planning, storytelling and production. (Jostens Yearbook Curriculum, 2010)
- Publish OCSI yearbook volume that accurately reflects school year 2016-17
- Contribute to OCSI's social media promotion/presence
- Students will be assigned to a specialization in photography, design, writing or editing.

Materials Needed:

- Small notebook or index/note cards
- Writing utensils
- Binder or folder
- Planner/agenda
- SLR camera/photo taking device

Grading Policy:

- Planning & design 50%
- Submission work 20%
- Collaborative work 15%
- Deadline compliance 15%

Class Expectations:

- Media Design is a demanding course for students, as each student will be expected to complete homework and meet deadlines for assigned areas (reporting, photography, design)
- Be on time to class, ALWAYS use class time for Media Design assignments
- Best practice in teamwork & personal responsibility - this class gives you marketable experience in print media publishing - act like it!

 - Spring pictures/retakes
 - Final submission to Jostens
- **Fourth Quarter**
 - Students will continue to contribute to OCSIconnect/social media
 - Photography Portfolio
 - OCSI promotion video
